Ernie Newman



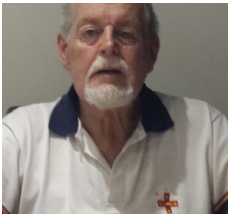

The AGM will be held this year so give some thought to putting your hand up to take on a roll on the committee to take share the load of running this great club. Be a doer not just a user.

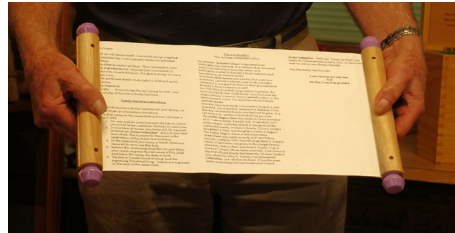
